BUCHANAN, to "task the Life Membership Chairman with detailing the cost per Life Membership cards" and task Ernie NELSON to "bring in a detailed proposal for a New Life Membership" to be presented at the next Convention. By a voice vote, ALL Ayes and NO Nays. This MOTION passed.

Discussion: Benny **HERNANDEZ** about going to other vendors.

Dave **PEARSON** asked who assigns the Life Membership numbers? The Life Membership Chairman assigns the numbers for whoever prints the card.

990n e-POST Cards

Charlie **COFFIN** explained how the IRS form 990n post card works. All Islands need to file their own form 990n post cards, annually.

Jim **ZYWOT** relayed his experience in getting Island X-9 Jacksonville reinstated with the IRS.
