NSVA take responsibility of maintaining donated Monuments to National Cemeteries.

Midyear 2022

RESOLUTIONS Committee report;

The Resolution proposed by Normand O. Dupuis was read for the meeting as it was not introduced to the system properly.

In a report from the Resolution Committee detailing the Resolution and all the parts that were incorrect, it was decided to send **Resolution 2022-01** to the National Convention of the General membership with the **recommendation to disapprove** on the grounds it is not NSVA program, only recognized as a most worthy cause and once a Monument has been donated it **becomes the sole property of the VA National Cemetery system**. However, it was pointed out that this would make a wonderful suggestion for Islands and SEABEES to consider doing, going through the proper channels.

After discussion there was **MOTION** made by Treasurer Jerry **SCHMUCK** and seconded by Vice Commander Anthony **AMESQUITA** to send Resolution 2022-01 to the Convention floor with the **recommendation to Disapprove**.

By a voice vote ALL ayes and NO nays. This Motion was approved to send forward.

After being introduced to the General membership of the 2022 Convention and Reunion and explained and discussed thoroughly the Resolution was put to a vote.

Roger **JACOBSEN**, Island X-2 Twin City spoke about the ordeal of trying to get a SEABEE Monument repaired at **Fort Snelling National Cemetery** in Minnesota. The process lasted over 2 years.

There was a **MOTION** made by Ernie **NELSON** and seconded by Jerry **SCHMUCK** to accept the Resolution Committee's recommendation to **disapprove Resolution 2022-01 as presented**.

By a voice vote, ALL ayes and NO nays. This **resolution was disapproved**.

PRODEDURE AND RITUAL MANUAL UPDATES;

Charlie explained the updates to the manual, corrections in grammar, reclaiming the original colors of the Official logo as prescribed by Frank **IAFRATES** and updating to the Uniform specifications. This document will be posted on the NSVA website.

There was a **MOTION** made by Chett **WINCHELL** and seconded by Theresa **BRANDES** to approve the committee's changes and updating of the Rituals and Procedures manual as presented.

Paul **PATTERSON**, Dept. of Ohio Commander, spoke about the state of Ohio having Service Officers in every county as a paid position.

NEW BUSINESS:

Attendee's need to fill out the Convention and Reunion **COMPLETELY!**

The case in point, the "**Commanders Trophy**" given to the unit having the most members in attendance at the Convention and Reunion.

Each Registration form has a section to list "**Units served with**" and most registrations were left blank.

Charlie **COFFIN** called for a show of hands for the four "Units" most cited on the Registration form to complete a tally for the award.

RE-ACTIVATION OF THE NATIONAL AT LARGE;

There will be **ONE official meeting** per year and that will be the National Convention and Reunion.

There was a **MOTION** made by Chett **WINCHELL** and seconded by Roy **AGUILLON** to approve the **Re-activation of the National Island at large.**

By a voice vote, most ayes and **one opposed.** This Motion was **approved.**

Ralph **BEAN** suggested changing the name from "**ISLAND** at Large" to "**MEMBERS** at Large".

Request from Davisville for support to become a "Most worthy project" of the NSVA.

There is a project underway to refurbish the "Chapel in the Pines" and they are seeking donations.

There was a **MOTION** made by Chett **WINCHELL** and seconded by Mike **ADAMSEN** to recognize the "**DAVISVILLE MUSEUM AND MEMORIAL PARK**" in **Rhode Island** as a most worthy project of the NSVA.

Charlie **COFFIN** will set out a donation receptacle for any and all free will donations to this project and at the end of the Convention and Reunion, the proceeds will be mailed to X-1 Davisville as the administrators.

Establishing a method for **ONLINE PAYMENTS** to the National Organization for Convention Registrations.

X-1 San Antonio Texas is going to be the **test site for establishing an online payment** method explained by Benny **HERNANDEZ**.

Jack **TANGEN** explained to the group that he had received the authorization from the Board of Directors to form a feasibility committee to see if an Audit is warranted. He will form the committee soon.
