

Article IV Section 5, NATIONAL ISLAND AT LARGE

MEMBERSHIP

The National Island at Large shall be for members residing in a State, territory, or area where there is no active Island.

When an Island is formed in a member's area, they have the option of transferring to that Island or remaining in the National Island at Large. or area,

The established policy of membership assignment in the National Island at Large shall be as provided in Standing Rule 3.

There is also a (3) Year membership available at a reduced cost of \$50.00.

A Life Membership is also available from the age table in Article III, Membership.

There is a provision for making installment payments to the National Island at Large over a (10) month period. In the event of said member being unable to complete the full payment within the time limit of (10) months or in case of death of the applicant before full payment is made, a refund to the applicant or his/her heirs, less \$25 Dollars (\$25.00) for administrative expenses of handling the installments and 1 year ANNUAL membership, shall be made to the Island, National Island at Large, Battalion or Unit at Large, through which said member made application

DUES.

Dues for the National Island at Large shall be set at the National Convention and shall be \$20.00.

NATIONAL VICE COMMANDER,

The National Vice Commander at Large shall serve as the presiding Officer of the National Island at Large.

The **NATIONAL SECRETARY** shall be the Secretary of the National Island at Large with the same duties as listed in subsections A-E of ARTICLE VIII, National Executive Committee

. The National Secretary shall make a report to the National Executive Committee and the General Membership on the status of the National Island at Large during the report of Officers.

DELEGATES and ALTERNATES to the NATIONAL CONVENTION

The Delegates of the National Island at large, Units and Islands At Large shall be elected at the annual meeting of said Unit and Island, held in conjunction with the National Convention, the number of qualified votes being as specified for Islands in Section 2 of this Article.

Delegates elected shall be accredited upon remittance of registration and delegate fees and the credential form submitted to the Credentials Committee via the National Secretary by the Chairman of the Island meeting.
